



On Tracy's wedding day, she wore bruises under her dress. After he beat her, she felt shock, disbelief and fear. Despite his promises to change, he never did, leaving Tracy with a permanent brain injury. Her experience galvanized her parents to help victims of abuse in the Tri-Cities. Her mom, Mary Ann Ingram, was a founding board member of James House. Her dad, Delegate Riley Ingram, helped pass a law that redefined stalking and increased penalties for abusers.
